

Privacy Policy

We are Free Society Limited, a company registered in the Isle of Man, company no. 133886C. We believe in maximising your privacy and confidentiality, in keeping with good business practice and the law, which for us is the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR). This policy explains what personal data we use, as well as why and how we use it and what it means for you.

The only personal data we collect is your email address. You provide it to us when you subscribe to project updates via our website (freesociety.com). The legal basis under which we hold that data is your consent.

Your email address will only be used to send occasional updates on the project. Due to the long-term nature of the project, these updates are rare. As such, we will retain your data for up to ten years in our email marketing platform, which is provided by MailChimp and subject to their high security standards.

Your data will not be given to any other organisations or legal jurisdictions. If the company is involved in a merger, acquisition, or asset sale, your data may be transferred, in which case we will provide you with advanced notice and the opportunity to opt out.

Under the GDPR you have several rights, as explained [here](#). Given the limited nature of the data we hold, the most relevant is the right of erasure i.e. we will remove your email address from our list on request.
